## **CAMP DIRECTORS**



## BLAIR REID HEAD MEN'S SOCCER COACH

Blair Reid, entering his 34th season as men's head soccer coach at Grand View, has a record of 416-226-36. He has coached the Vikings to 16 Midwest Collegiate Conference Championships, 14 MCC Tournament Championships, seven NAIA District 15 Championships, one

NAIA Region VII Championship and 11 National Tournament appearances, including the Final Four in 2016. He has been named NAIA Region Coach of the Year five times, MCC Coach of the Year nine times, and District Coach of the Year seven times. He has coached 51 All-Americans and 39 Academic All-American Scholars during his tenure.

Reid coached USL member the Des Moines Menace from 1994-1997 and was head boys' coach for Dowling High School from 1985-1993. In 2001 he was inducted into the lowa High School Soccer Coaches Hall of Fame. Reid was instrumental in establishing soccer as a state-sanctioned high school sport in lowa.



## AL DRISCOLL ASSISTANT MEN'S SOCCER COACH

Al Driscoll is in his eighth season as assistant coach. A former Viking, Driscoll was a three-time captain and guided the Vikings to four consecutive District 15 Championships. He was All-District First Team four times, and a two-time Region and All-American selection.

His professional playing career includes stints with NPSL Illinois Thunder, the USISL Indoor League (Permian Basin) TX, USISL Outdoor League with Austin Soccadillos, TX, player for the

Des Moines Menace 1994-1997, and player and coach for the 1998-99, Menace making consecutive trips to the USL Final Four. He was also a two-time All-star selection. Driscoll was a player and coach for the USL Select Atlanta Silverbacks.

He has coached many seasons of youth soccer in Central lowa, including several state championships and region semi-finalists.



## AUGIE GUTIERREZ ASSISTANT MEN'S SOCCER COACH

Augie Gutierrez is in his third season as an assistant coach with the Vikings. A former Grand View player, Gutierrez was three-time team captain and guided the Vikings to three District 15 championships. He was voted to the All-District First Team four-times

and was both a three-time All-Region and All-American selection. His professional playing career includes five years with the Des Moines Menace, and one year each with Sioux City Breeze and in Kansas City.

Gutierrez has coached youth soccer in Central lowa, including starting Next Level Soccer Training in 2013 which is geared toward helping young players reach their maximum soccer potential.
